



IMT-GT GREEN CITY AWARDS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ) SHEET

1. Who is eligible?

All cities within the IMT-GT subregion i.e. cities/municipalities in 10 Sumatra provinces (Indonesia), 11 Peninsular states (Malaysia), 14 southern provinces (Thailand).

2. Can a city submit more than one application?

Cities may submit multiple applications, with each application limited to one award category per city.

3. What is the difference between Bronze, Silver, and Gold tiers?

- **Bronze:** Planning & early implementation
- **Silver:** Demonstrated implementation with measurable progress
- **Gold:** High performance and leadership in sustainability

4. What type of evidence is required?

Evidence must be verifiable and aligned with the indicator tiers, such as policies, data, photos, reports, and other supporting materials. All written submissions must be in **English**.

5. How will the Awards be evaluated and decided?

The Expert Panel will score submissions based on a two-tier framework comprising Technical Indicators and five Core Criteria. Please refer to the Assessment Framework Summary Guide for details.

6. Will the winning cities receive any reward?

Yes. All recognised cities will receive an official IMT-GT Green City Award Certificate and be featured on the IMT-GT Green Cities Best Practice Platform. Awarded initiatives will also gain visibility through IMT-GT and partner networks, supporting wider knowledge sharing, peer learning, and regional recognition of best practices.

7. When will winners be announced?

The winners will be officially announced at the annual IMT-GT Ministerial Meeting, typically held in September each year.

8. If the application cannot be submitted via the online form, can the application materials be submitted via email?

9. Can the applicant add more application materials after the deadline?

No additional application materials will be accepted after the submission deadline. However, CIMT may reach out to applicants for clarification on their application.
